# **Depot Locations & Pick-Up Timing**

- Motorhome depots are usually just off the airport, with a complimentary shuttle service available.
- Last vehicle pick-up is generally at 3 pm
- If arriving in the afternoon, we recommend an overnight stay at an airport hotel before collecting the motorhome the next day

# **Booking & Payment Info**

- Deposit = 20% of vehicle cost (in addition to ANZCRO's \$110pp deposit)
- Deposit is required at time of booking or deposit if within cancellation window
- For your booking to be successful, you must provide a full driver's license (or IDP) in English and be 21 years of age or older.

# **Key Features:**

 GPS Location Services: Nearest campsites, dump stations, petrol stations, toilets, supermarkets, and LPG fill-up points

- Offline Maps: Save maps to use without internet/data

# **Freedom Camping in New Zealand:**

- Freedom camping is allowed at designated sites, public land where permitted, and some DOC campsites.
- You can't camp in national parks (unless at designated campsites), on private land without permission, or in restricted council areas.
- Fines apply for camping in non-permitted areas always check for No Freedom Camping signs.
- Use apps like CamperMate or Rankers to find permitted spots and stay updated on local rules.
- Follow Leave No Trace: dispose of waste properly, respect wildlife, and leave sites as you found them.

# **THL Vehicle Policy:**

- Maui, Britz & Mighty allow their vehicles on the ferry.
- You are not required to switch vehicles between islands (unlike some older policies)
- You must book ferry travel in advance, especially in peak season

# Booking Tip: When booking a ferry, you'll need

- Vehicle type (e.g. campervan/motorhome)
- Vehicle length (THL will advise this on booking)
- Passenger details

### Cost:

- The fare includes both passengers + vehicle
- Prices vary depending on the time of year and ferry company

# **Optional Add-Ons & Excess Reduction**

 Standard insurance excess for motorhomes can be significant
